



GO Required Systems Set Up Windows 10


About this Document

This document provides procedures for setting up GO on your computer with Windows 10 Operating System (OS). It includes 2 Phases: Install Citrix and Configure the Browser.

Installing Citrix

<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Open a browser and go to receiver.citrix.com. 2) Click Download Receiver 4.4 for Windows. <p><i>NOTE: At this time, the Citrix Receiver from the Windows 10 App Store is not compatible.</i></p>	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 3) The Informational bar, which varies with each browser, appears once the file is downloaded. 4) Select Run to begin the installation. 	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 5) Click Start. 	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 6) Select I accept the license agreement box. 7) Click Next. 	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 8) Select No, Thanks. 9) Click Install. 	

10) Click **Finish**.



Configure the Browser

1) Open one of the following browsers: Edge, Chrome, or Firefox.




NOTE: Edge is the new Microsoft Browser in Windows 10.

2) For Edge and Chrome, skip to Step 8.


3) For Firefox: In the upper right corner of the browser, click the **Menu** button (it has 3 horizontal lines).



4) A drop down menu appears. Select the **Add-Ons** icon.




5) On the left, click the **Plugins** tab. A list of all plugins appears.



6) From the list of plugins, find **Citrix Receiver** and select the drop-down menu.


7) From the drop menu to **Always Activate**.



8) Navigate to <http://go.state.gov> and scroll to the bottom of the screen. Select **I agree** to continue.



9) At the bottom of the next page, select **Windows 8/10**.



10) Enter your credentials and select **Login**.
